

HELPING MAKE SPACE ACCESSIBLE WITH CLUB FOR THE FUTURE & POSTCARDS TO SPACE

Space United® is also collaborating with <u>Blue Origin</u>'s <u>Club for the</u> <u>Future</u> to help inspire youth to imagine careers in space and to help make space and STEM education accessible for all.

Students draw their vision of life & sports in space on a postcard and together with Club for the Future, we launch the postcards on Blue Origin's New Shepard rocket!

Postcards are then returned to students with a certified "flown to space" stamp.

The academy will provide a pathway for players to develop and transition into our flagship teams.








CAMILO TOBACIA, FOUNDER & CEO






